

Important information regarding the 2017 Part III examinations

Please take note of the following points:

- ❖ Please leave outdoor clothing, rucksacks, bags etc. outside the exam room, or at the back of the room well away from your desk.
- ❖ Do not take mobile phones, smart watches, or any other electronic devices, including calculators, into the exam room. If you have these in your possession, the Invigilator has the authority to confiscate them for the duration of the examination.
- ❖ You may bring into the exam room a small screw-cap bottle of water to keep at your desk. No other items of food or drink are allowed.
- ❖ You may not read the question paper until instructed to do so by the Invigilator.
- ❖ Read carefully the instructions for the examination paper before starting.
- ❖ Do not write with red or green pen anywhere on your exam.
- ❖ You are not allowed to leave the examination room until half an hour after the examination started. After that time, you may leave if you wish, but you will not be allowed to return unless you have been accompanied by an attendant to the toilet, for example.
- ❖ If you need to speak to the Invigilator during the exam, (for extra paper or with a query) please raise your hand and they will come over to you.
- ❖ When your examination has finished, please:
 - (a) arrange your scripts on your desk, tied together with master sheets etc.;
 - (b) make sure that you have written your candidate number on the cover sheet;
 - (c) include any rough work if appropriate since this might give rise to additional credit;
 - (d) leave the room as quietly as possible.
